







Ohrid tourism opportunities and connectivity

Due to positive changes in the legislative, within the past 7 years, the numbers of foreign tourists and overnights in Macedonia have been doubled

One of the major reasons for this were the subsidies offered for foreign tourism turnover

- Groups of minimum 10 passengers
- Staying minimum 3 nights in officially categorized accommodation facilities
- Using minimum BB service
- The amount depends on the transportation type and country of origin
- There are 13 countries with preferential subsidies (from 2015 will be 19)

Low-cost carrier subsidies

- The Government will pay off 5 million Euros in a period of 3 years
- The low-cost carrier has to:
 - -minimum 7 destinations,
 - -with minimum 2 weekly rotations
 - -set up a technical base in Macedonia and
 - -register one plane under Macedonian flag
 - Till September this year there have been over 1 million passengers

Better competitiveness on the market by lowering VAT for BB, HB and FB

- The new VAT rate for the 3 basic hotel services: BB, HB and FB is 5%
- Hotels can offer lower prices of these services
- The tourist packages offered on the international market are with very acceptable prices

Seasonality

- Tourism season lasts close to 6 months
- In addition to that approximately 30 days of winter season on 3 winter sports centers
- 2 more ski centers near Ohrid Lake are in project stages which would offer wiretransporters that would provide access to the mountain peaks all year round



Ohrid can be reached by:

- Airplane There are 2 international airports (Skopje and Ohrid)
- Bus There are regular daily bus lines to Skopje and Bitola with interconnections to many European destinations, as well as regular international lines
- Car, Motorbike, Bike European route E-75
 passes through Macedonia. Macedonia is a
 country of mountains and the road to Ohrid will
 give the passenger a chance to enjoy beautiful
 sceneries

Road infrastructure improvements

- Construction of the corridor 8 and corridor 10 highways
- Reconstructing approximately 400 km of local and national roads
- Better access roads to the tourism sites

A variety of programs are offered for tourists:

- Walking trails all over the country
- Mountain biking
- Paragliding
- Diving in the oldest lake of Europe
- Wine routes
- Historical and cultural heritage trails

 - many other tourist attractions
- The Balkan as one tourism destination by cross border cooperation
